



Prof. Peter Neumann

Peter Neumann is Professor of Security Studies at the Department of War Studies, King's College London, and serves as Director of the International Centre for the Study of Radicalisation (ICSR), which he founded in early 2008. Neumann has authored or co-authored five books, including *Old and New Terrorism*, published by Polity Press in 2009; and *The Strategy of Terrorism* (with MLR Smith), published by Routledge in 2008. He is the author of numerous peer-reviewed articles, dealing with different aspects of terrorism and radicalization. Shorter pieces have appeared in the *New York Times*, the *New Scientist*, the *London Review of Books*, the *Wall Street Journal*, and other periodicals. Neumann has led research projects and written influential policy reports about issues such as online radicalization, foreign fighter networks, prison-based de-radicalization programs, and terrorist recruitment in Europe. The most recent are "#Greenbirds: Measuring Importance and Influence in Syrian Foreign Fighter Networks" (ICSR, April 2014; with Joseph Carter and Shiraz Maher) and "Countering Online Radicalization in America" (Bipartisan Policy Center, December 2012).
